- 1. Jason says that he has a learning disability? What is a definition of a learning disability?
- 2. Do you know people who have learning disabilities? How do their disabilities affect them? What are their strengths?
- 3. Why do you think that Eileen kept her learning disability a secret for so many years?

Chapter 1 Struggling to Learn

- 1. Have you had students in your classes who had difficulty reading? How did teachers help students who had reading difficulties?
- 2. How would it feel if reading was as difficult for you as it was for Eileen?
- 3. Many of Eileen's classmates bullied her. What can be done to stop bullying?
- 4. When Elliot and Eileen were working with their father, they were hiding the spelling words under the table. Were they cheating? Were they wrong to do that?
- 4. Are there skills that your sibling can do that you can't do as well? How does this make you feel?
